



AGREEMENT BETWEEN NASAR AND AN ORGANIZATION SPONSORING A NASAR COURSE and/or CERTIFICATION

1. Assure the course instructor(s) are properly approved to teach the prescribed course of instruction.
2. NASAR will provide all necessary course materials to properly present the prescribed course of instruction with costs determined by a separate document.
3. NASAR will issue course completion certificates to all participants who successfully complete the course. Such certificates will indicate successful completion of the approved course of study and do not constitute a license to perform or certification of competence for actual performance.

The sponsoring organization agrees that any account unpaid within 30 calendar days from the date of the original invoice, will be subject to payment of interest at the rate of 1½ percent per month for each month, or part thereof, that the account remains delinquent.

The sponsoring organization agrees to save, protect and hold harmless the National Association for Search and Rescue and its agents against all liabilities and claims outside the scope and conditions of this and other accompanying contracts. In particular,

The sponsoring organization acknowledges that:

--The course materials are not meant to replace field training by competent search, rescue and emergency response leaders or to replace actual experience. Endorsement of specific equipment is not implied.

--It is the duty of every agency, organization and individual with search, rescue and emergency response responsibilities to obtain the knowledge to perform effective, efficient, emergency operations.

We believe the information contained in these materials will serve as the beginning outline and body of knowledge for proper search or emergency management. NASAR, the authors and contributors do not represent it as a complete standard for performance.

Both Parties agree equally that:

Upon the written request of either party to the other, any difference, dispute or claim that may arise under or in connection with this agreement shall be submitted to binding arbitration hereunder. Such arbitration shall be held NASAR headquarters offices, in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules then in effect of the American Arbitration Association. The decision of such arbitration shall be binding on both parties, and a judgment on an award rendered shall be entered in any court of appropriate subject matter jurisdiction located within the State of Virginia.
